

Paint a Parking Spot

Design Guidelines

- 1. Designs must be able to be enjoyed by all & suitable to be viewed by all ages...
- 2. Think of your parking spot design as a t-shirt that you want to wear to school. Your spot should be fun & reflect who you are as a person. Keep it classy!
- 3. You can only use exterior, water based, latex paints. More details will be available closer to paint day including supplies to bring. No oil-based paints allowed. No spray paint, fluorescent paint, or glitter paint. If in doubt, ask the paint department at the store or email: novisanp2025@gmail.com.
- 4. You provide the primer, base paint, paint for design & all supplies needed to complete your design.
- 5. No name calling, group bashing, or singling out others is allowed, including neighboring schools.
- 6. No drug or alcohol references.
- 7. No profanity or obscene gestures. No double entendre (word/phrase open to two interpretations, one of which is usually risqué or indecent).
- 8. No nudity or sexual references. No gang references. No political references or statements.
- 9. No QR codes, Spotify codes, or other scannable codes allowed.
- 10. The reserving student's name is the ONLY name/initials allowed to be painted on the spot. (NO boyfriend/girlfriend/friends, etc.).
- 11. An unpainted border must be maintained in the parking spot. The design cannot come within six (6) inches of the district painted (white or yellow) lines.
- 12. Design must be approved by NHS Administration BEFORE you start painting. Any artwork depicting items, symbols or language deemed inappropriate by NHS Administration will not be permitted.

ADDITIONAL GUIDANCE:

- 1. You understand that this is separate from the annual process of registering for a parking pass at NHS.
- You understand that in order to have a painted parking spot, you must also register AND PAY for a parking pass through NHS. The painted parking spot is a fundraiser for SANP 2025 and DOES NOT include the parking pass fee charged by NHS.
- 3. You understand that reserved parking privileges are designed for use during the normal school day & does not apply to after school events, weekends, etc. Your space may be occupied by others during these off-times.
- 4. Any NHS student that paints a parking spot without permission or vandalizes a senior parking spot will lose their parking privileges.
- 5. The upkeep of the space is the responsibility of the student. If for some reason the space needs to be repainted (because of graffiti or other reason), the student must speak with their counselor immediately.
- 6. Prohibited, or unapproved designs will be painted over at the discretion of NHS Administration.
- 7. All students understand that they are not to park in any painted spot that is not their own during the school day.
- 8. If any NHS student parks in a senior student's assigned parking spot:
 - a. 1st offense, student will receive a warning & be asked to move their car immediately.
 - b. 2nd offense, student will receive a disciplinary consequence & will be asked to move their car immediately.
 - c. 3rd offense, student will lose their parking privileges at NHS for the remainder of the year.
- 9. If a student arrives at school and finds another vehicle parked in their reserved painted space, the student needs to:
 - a. Park in an available (non-painted) parking space (not another painted space) and bring the information below to the main office. Do not make this a reason to be late to class!
 - b. Take a picture of the car, license plate number, and Novi HS parking tag number to the front NHS Administration office.
